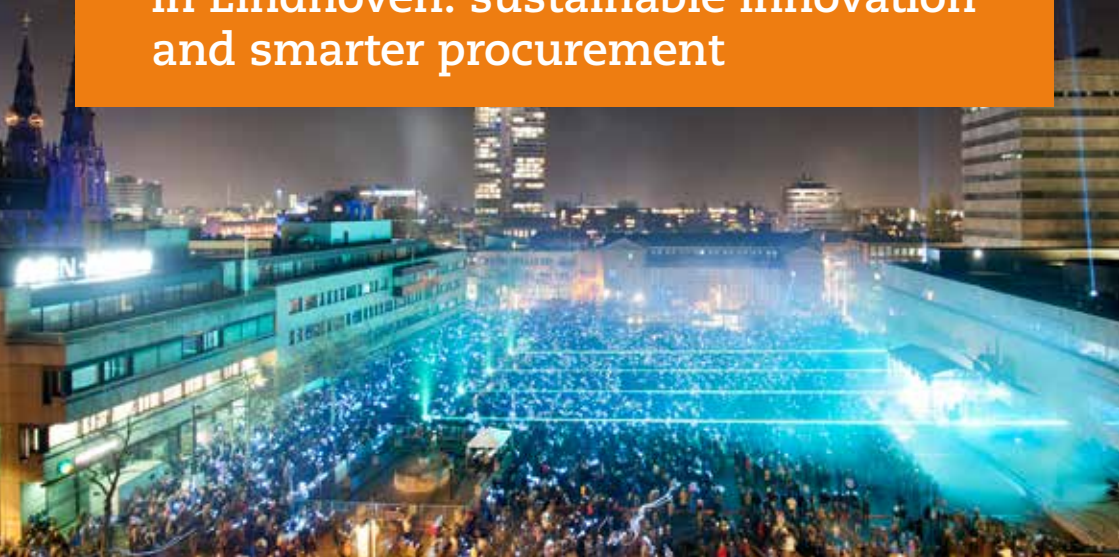

Renovation of municipal buildings in Eindhoven: sustainable innovation and smarter procurement

The city of Eindhoven has a history in which design, innovation and technological developments play a key role. Today Eindhoven is at the forefront of design and technology, with major technology players located in the area.

By 2035 Eindhoven intends to become fully energy neutral. This implies that all the energy that the city uses, is produced sustainably. From that ambition initiatives for the generation of renewable energy are supported.

European collaboration

With this in mind, Eindhoven joined the European project SPEA (Smart Procurement European Alliance). The SPEA project aims are in line with Eindhoven's aim to accelerate the adoption of innovative sustainable technologies through smarter procurement.

Eindhoven (NL), Birmingham (UK) and Barcelona (ESP) have undertaken the task of researching public procurement in the area of energy efficiency within municipal buildings. An exchange of knowledge about methods,

technologies and local market conditions will take place between the city partners. This will eventually lead to concrete measures being taken within municipal buildings in these respective cities, utilizing State of the Art methods, technologies and principles.

Sustainable renovation

The city of Eindhoven has chosen the Eindhoven town hall and the connected office tower as a business case in the SPEA project. Local players and stakeholders within the Eindhoven region will be invited to apply innovative technologies, business models and financing methods to the challenge of sustainably renovating these two buildings. The renovation must be completed in 2016.
